

30 Days of Prayer

“He Must Increase, But I Must Decrease” (John 3:30)

“Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.” — Colossians 4:2

This 30-day prayer guide follows our 2026 preaching journey through Genesis, Exodus, the Gospels, Acts, Romans, and Ruth. Each day includes a Scripture reference, a key biblical theme, and a prayer focus to help us seek the Lord together as a church family.

Day 1 – The Call of Faith

Scripture: Genesis 12:1-9

Key Verse: “Go from your country...” (Gen. 12:1)

Prayer: Lord, give us faith to obey You even when we cannot see the whole path ahead. Help us follow Christ wherever He leads.

Day 2 – Trusting God in Delays

Scripture: Genesis 15:1-6

Key Verse: “And he believed the LORD...” (Gen. 15:6)

Prayer: Father, strengthen those who are waiting on You. Help us trust Your timing and promises.

Day 3 – God’s Covenant and Our Confidence

Scripture: Genesis 17:1-14

Key Verse: “I will establish my covenant...” (Gen. 17:7)

Prayer: Thank You for Your unchanging faithfulness. Help us rest confidently in Your promises.

Day 4 – The Test of Faith

Scripture: Genesis 22:1-19

Key Verse: “God will provide...” (Gen. 22:8)

Prayer: Teach us to surrender everything to You, (*past-present-future*) and trust Your perfect provision.

Day 5 – The Oppression

Scripture: Exodus 1:8-22

Key Verse: “The more they were oppressed, the more they multiplied.” (Ex. 1:12)

Prayer: Strengthen disciples of Christ who are facing trials and persecution. Help us remain faithful under pressure.

Day 6 – The Reluctant Leader

Scripture: Exodus 3:1-18

Key Verse: “I will be with you.” (Ex. 3:12)

Prayer: Raise up humble, godly leaders who depend upon Your strength rather than their own abilities.

Day 7 – The Blood of the Lamb

Scripture: Exodus 12:1-30

Key Verse: “When I see the blood, I will pass over you.” (Ex. 12:13)

Prayer: Thank You for Jesus, our Passover Lamb. Help us never lose the wonder at the cross.

Day 8 – Crossing Over by Faith

Scripture: Exodus 14:1-31

Key Verse: “The LORD will fight for you.” (Ex. 14:14)

Prayer: Help us trust You in impossible situations and remember Your power to save.

Day 9 – The Bread from Heaven

Scripture: Exodus 16:1-36

Key Verse: “Give us this day our daily bread.” (Matt. 6:11)

Prayer: Teach us daily dependence upon Christ and gratitude for Your provision.

Day 10 – The Golden Calf

Scripture: Exodus 32:1-35

Key Verse: “You shall have no other gods before me.” (Ex. 20:3)

Prayer: Reveal and remove all idols (*any person/place/thing that becomes ultimate*) from our hearts. Help us worship Christ alone.

Day 11 – The Glory of God’s Presence

Scripture: Exodus 33:12-23

Key Verse: “My presence will go with you.” (Ex. 33:14)

Prayer: May Your presence be our greatest desire and highest treasure.

Day 12 – He Will Be with You

Scripture: Deuteronomy 31:1-15

Key Verse: “He will not leave you or forsake you.” (Deut. 31:6)

Prayer: Help us walk courageously, knowing You are always with Your people.

Day 13 – Hosanna in the Highest

Scripture: Mark 11:1-11

Key Verse: “Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!” (Mk. 11:9)

Prayer: May Christ be welcomed and honoured as King and LORD in every area of our lives.

Day 14 – It Is Finished

Scripture: John 19:16-30

Key Verse: “It is finished.” (Jn. 19:30)

Prayer: Thank You, Lord Jesus, for completing the work of redemption on our behalf.

Day 15 – Doubting and Believing

Scripture: John 20:19-31

Key Verse: “My Lord and my God!” (Jn. 20:28)

Prayer: Strengthen our faith and help those who struggle with doubt.

Day 16 – Of First Importance

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

Key Verse: “Christ died for our sins.” (1 Cor. 15:3)

Prayer: Keep the gospel, the whole counsel of God central in our church. In our preaching, discipleship, worship, and mission.

Day 17 – Angels Long to Look

Scripture: 1 Peter 1:1-12

Key Verse: “Things into which angels long to look.” (1 Pet. 1:12)

Prayer: Give us a deeper appreciation for the salvation we have in Christ.

Day 18 – The Harvest Is Plentiful

Scripture: Luke 10:1-12

Key Verse: “The harvest is plentiful.” (Lk. 10:2)

Prayer: Raise up labourers and give us boldness to share the gospel.

Day 19 – The Promise of the Spirit

Scripture: Acts 1:1-11

Key Verse: “You will receive power.” (Acts 1:8)

Prayer: Help us rely on the Holy Spirit in every aspect of life and ministry.

Day 20 – Pentecost Power

Scripture: Acts 2:1-14

Key Verse: “They were all filled with the Holy Spirit.” (Acts 2:4)

Prayer: Fill us with courage, conviction, wisdom, and spiritual fruit.

Day 21 – The Boldness of the Apostles

Scripture: Acts 4:13-22

Key Verse: “We cannot but speak.” (Acts 4:20)

Prayer: Give us the courage to speak openly and graciously about Jesus.

Day 22 – The Church’s First Martyr

Scripture: Acts 7:51-60

Key Verse: “Lord, do not hold this sin against them.” (Acts 7:60)

Prayer: Help us demonstrate Christlike boldness.

Day 23 – Saul’s Radical Transformation

Scripture: Acts 9:23-31

Key Verse: “If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation.” (2 Cor. 5:17)

Prayer: Save the lost and transform lives through the power of the gospel.

Day 24 – Peter’s Rescue

Scripture: Acts 12:1-11

Key Verse: “The Lord has sent his angel.” (Acts 12:11)

Prayer: Thank You for Your sovereign care and protection over Your people.

Day 25 – Spoke in Such a Way

Scripture: Acts 14:1-7

Key Verse: “A great number who believed.” (Acts 14:1)

Prayer: May our words and lives point others to faith in Christ.

Day 26 – Paul in Athens

Scripture: Acts 17:16-34

Key Verse: “What therefore you worship as unknown...” (Acts 17:23)

Prayer: Give us wisdom to engage our culture with biblical truth and gospel love.

Day 27 – The Whole Counsel of God

Scripture: Acts 20:17-38

Key Verse: “The whole counsel of God.” (Acts 20:27)

Prayer: Pray for faithful expository preaching, biblical discipleship, and spiritual maturity.

Day 28 – The Power of the Gospel

Scripture: Romans 1:1-17

Key Verse: “I am not ashamed of the gospel.” (Rom. 1:16)

Prayer: Help us boldly proclaim the gospel as the power of God for salvation.

Day 29 – Alive in Christ

Scripture: Romans 6:1-14

Key Verse: “Alive to God in Christ Jesus.” (Rom. 6:11)

Prayer: Strengthen us to walk in holiness and victory over sin.

Day 30 – The Lord’s Faithfulness

Scripture: Ruth 4:13-22

Key Verse: “The LORD’s faithfulness endures to all generations.” (Psalm 100:5)

Prayer: Thank You for Your faithfulness through every generation. Continue to build Your church, save the lost, disciple believers, strengthen families, raise up leaders, and glorify Your name through The Gathering Church Windsor.
